## 1. RULES

- 1.1 The regatta will be governed by the rules as defined in *The Racing Rules of Sailing*.
- 1.2 The Prescriptions and Special Regulations of Yachting Australia Inc. (YA) – Part 2.
- 1.3 Any class rules
- 1.4 If there is a conflict between languages the English text will take precedence.

## 2. ADVERTISING

- 2.1 Advertising will be restricted to Category C.
- 2.2 Boats may be required to display advertising chosen and supplied by the organising authority.

## 3. ELIGIBILITY AND ENTRY

- 3.1 The regatta is open to the following international classes:
  - International Optimist
  - Laser 4.7
  - Laser Radial
  - International 420
  - 29er
  - Sailboard
  - Hobie 16 (with spinnaker)
- 3.2 Invited national classes as follows:
  - Sabot 1up and 2up
  - Pacer
- 3.3 All competitors shall apply with rule 46 and 55.
- 3.4 All competitors must be under 19 years as of 31 December 2009.
- 3.5 Proof of age and Yachting Australia membership shall be required.
- 3.6 The signed Code of Conduct Agreement shall be received at the time of registration.
- 3.7 When entry is accepted details will be displayed on [www.qldyouthweek.com](http://www.qldyouthweek.com)
- 3.8 Eligible boats may enter by completing the attached form and sending it, together with the required fee to by no later than 1700 Friday 26 June 2009:

## 6. MEASUREMENTS

Each boat shall comply with the relevant measurement criteria as per their class rules.

## 7. SAILING INSTRUCTIONS

The Sailing Instructions will be available at registration.

## 8. VENUE

8.1 Attachment 1 shows the location of the regatta harbour.

8.2 Attachment 2 shows the location of the racing areas.

## 9. THE COURSES

The courses will be trapezoid with inner and outer loops or windward/returns. All courses will be detailed in the Sailing Instructions.

## 10. PENALTY SYSTEM

Hobie 16s only: Rule 44.1 is changed so that the Two-Turns Penalty is replaced by the One-Turn Penalty.

## 11. SCORING

- 11.1 The Low Point Scoring System of Appendix A will apply.
- 11.2 Three (3) races are required to be completed to constitute a series.
- 11.3 (a) When six (6) or fewer races have been completed, a boat's series score will be the total of her race scores.  
(b) When from seven (7) to eight (8) races have been completed, a boat's series score will be the total of her race scores excluding her worst score.  
(c) When from nine (9) or more races have been completed, a boat's series score will be the total of her race scores excluding her worst two scores.

## 12. SUPPORT BOATS

Support boats shall be marked with a white flag with the numbers to identify which boat they are representing. All support boats are required to register to obtain this flag.

## 13. RADIO COMMUNICATION

Except in an emergency, a boat shall neither make radio transmissions while racing nor receive radio communications not available to all boats. This restriction also applies to mobile telephones.

## 14. PRIZES & DIVISIONS

Prizes will be given as follows:

- 14.1 Prizes will be awarded to 1<sup>st</sup>, 2<sup>nd</sup> and 3<sup>rd</sup> in each division.
- 14.2 An overall prize for the top ranked state will be awarded based on the overall results from the three highest ranked individual results.
- 14.3 Minimum six (6) entries to establish a division.

## 15. DISCLAIMER OF ENTRY

Competitors participate in the regatta entirely at their own risk. See rule 4, Decision to Race. The organising authority will not accept any liability for material damage or personal injury or death sustained in conjunction with or prior to, during, or after the regatta.

## 16. INSURANCE

Each participating boat shall be insured with valid third-party liability insurance with a minimum cover of \$5m per event or equivalent.
