2. REGISTRATION

Nomination fees to be paid to the race secretary no later than 1 hour prior to the start of the first heat. All competitors to note that they are required to pay normal club race fees.

3. ELIGIBILITY

To be eligible to enter, the helmsperson and forward hand must be financial members of the 125 Association and a sailing club affiliated with the Queensland Yachting Association. The boat must hold a current measurement certificate.

4. ENTRIES

Entries on the prescribed "Form of Entry" shall be lodged with the Race Secretary with the entry fee of \$20.

5. RULES

The Regatta will be governed by the current International Yacht Racing Rules, the Prescriptions and Safety Regulations of the Yachting Australian and the Class Rules of the 125 Association, (except as any of these are altered by the sailing instructions).

The regatta will be governed by the ISAF Racing Rules of Sailing, the Prescriptions and Safety Regulations of the Australian Yachting Federation and the Class Rules of the 125 Association, except as any of these are altered by the Notice of Race and the Sailing Instructions. Safety equipment, A.Y.F Safety Regulations, Addendum "A", Part 2 shall apply.

6. SAILING INSTRUCTIONS

All competitors shall be aware of the hosting clubs sailing instructions and attend a competitors meeting approximately 1 hour before the first warning signal of the day.

7. COURSES

The courses shall be specified in the sailing instructions of the host club.

8. SCORING SYSTEM

The Low Point Scoring System Appendix B2 of the racing rules shall apply. The best four races shall count for a boat's total point score. If only three (3) races are sailed all three shall count. A minimum of 3 races is necessary to constitute the series.

9. TROPHIES

Overall Placing's 1st to 3rd

Handicap 1st to 3rd

Junior Champion (Skipper and Crew under 18 at 1st December 2006)

Masters Champion (Skipper or Crew over age 40, or combination over 70 at 1st December 2006)

Note: No boat can win more than one prize

10. PUBLIC LIABILITY

A condition of entry is that each entrant carries at least 5 million dollars public liability
